We gathered for dinner on Friday night and then Jim Stephens made a presentation on the many resources that are available to parents and candidates, see <a href="http://www.themarriagelibrary.com/Matching/">http://www.themarriagelibrary.com/Matching/</a>

Each person introduced themselves and why they had come for the Retreat.

Dan explained how to use the site. He had requested that we provide him with suggestions for how to improve the site, so Jim led a discussion for gathering practical suggestions. They both shared very honestly and deeply about the many ups and downs they went through, even how they hurt each other. But through it all, they both continued to seek God first, so as a result they could share many valuable lessons. Many participants said this was the most memorable part of the Retreat.

Next was break time and a chance to go outside in the cold air and take a hike.

Because of the impending snow storm, we decided to shorten the program so everyone could get out safely.
