I Am My Brother's Keeper

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All right folks, beautiful day today! My goodness yesterday was a windstorm! Shout out to the Riders that came out yesterday to do some training!

Next week, we will have the open house for the welcome center. So, come on by for the barbecue and that's for the local folks as well, the friends that we've made in the last year or so, to join us here and we'll give a little tour of the property. It's time to meet the new folks in the community and of course our friends and neighbors here, and just be able to connect with the local folks. They're on the same page in terms of almost all of the conservative values that True Father has in his Kingdom, so they're already our patriot brothers and sisters. It's very important for us to show them the property, to love them up and to show them the community. People always say bad things about the Moonies being a cult, a gun cult, etc. They do that because they want people to stay away; they don't want people to actually see our community. Thank God for the internet; there are bad things about the internet but the good thing is that we get to show our community and show our content openly and freely. We don't hide anything so people are able to see what we believe and what we teach.

At the end of his earthly mission, Father released the God of Night and God of Day theology <https://www.sanctuary-pa.org/speeches/the-god-of-night-and-the-god-of-day> especially because of the fall of the Han mother; he knew that it would be essential to preempt that. What's amazing about it is that it shows the divinity of Christ; it shows that Christ is from the God of Night pre-creation so he's one with the Father even before creation. There's no real difference in terms of our main beliefs even our view about Jesus from the "normal" Orthodox church or Christian Church. They just have so many decades of persecuting us and haranguing us because of the reality of the fall and the insight that Father released to the world with the fall of man and the root of sin being sexual. Satan's power is tied sexually and all of his networks are tied by sexual blackmail because that's the root cause of the fall. It's the root cause of Satan's power, it's the root cause of Satan's network, it's the root cause of Satan's system.

Tying the Knot Every Week

The antidote to that of course is God's covenant of marriage and Father clarified it so clearly as the Returning Christ. Absolute sex and romance, that is the healthy, the powerful and godly sexuality for the marriage to flourish and to be the glue that binds the husband and the wife. *"The two shall be made one flesh."* (Matthew 19:5) Amen! So, they become one in mind, body heart and spirit.



Just as we talked about last week, it's not about just tying the knot once; it's about continuing to tie the knot. That's why what we call the spousal date training with your spouse is so critical because you're tying the knot again. These two chords which are separate pieces of paracord so-to-speak you're tying them. They're tied in marriage but then every time you do the date training with your wife, another knot is tied and tied, and tied. In one year, that's already fifty-two knots tied; in two years that's one hundred and four, etc. They just keep going, manifold increase. Every year your relationship gets tighter, your memories get tighter, your relationship gets stronger not weaker. Amen!

Satan wants it the opposite way; he wants you to be untying everything. He's actively trying to especially untie the knot of marriage; he's trying to untie that. But if you only got that and you're just busy making money and not tending to your family as a priest, then you're not doing your responsibility as a man. You can't only be about money; you're not supposed to just be a money factory for your children. You're supposed to also be a priest. That's your key job, that's your spiritual job and that's the job that's going to last when you die. Those values, your priestly duties of praying over your family and leading them in spiritual warfare; all these kinds of things, if you don't do that and you're just a man who is making money coming back home,

you're not doing your kingly duty or priestly duty. And your family will be wrecked; in a couple of years, they'll be wrecked. I guarantee it; you probably have a ninety percent plus chance of your marriage getting wrecked in about twenty years.

So do not do that! You have to be investors; think with investor mindset. You have to always be investing in your key assets which you will take from this world. What you will take from this world is your relationship with your wife, your children, your community et cetera. So, you got to put that time investment and training with your spouse. That's the spousal training.

All the young people they have a baby, they hand the baby over to grandpa and grandma and then they go on the date. Every time you do that date training, you're tying another knot in those two strands and those two strands now become one over time. Now they become not only paracords, little chords, they become a ROPE. How many people know a rope is stronger than a chord? (*Laughing*) Is that true? It becomes a rope that's intertwined so now all the weight of anything that it has to bear is held together by a chain-linked rope. Are you with me, folks? That's why the old adage of "tying the knot" is very incomplete. You don't only do it ONCE; you got to do it every WEEK.

That's backed up by the top psychological studies on mental HEALTH. Spouses need ninety minutes per week of eye-to-eye time together, otherwise their marriage will fall APART. I didn't know that when we were training twenty years ago and doing the spousal day training and I was encouraging all the members to do that. But you understand, that is critical for your spousal health, and of course your wife's mental health; especially if she's homemaker, she's doing that work, "*She's the homemaker, she's the culture changer, she's the culture maker, she's the queen, she's a chef and baker; she's a teacher and the chef and baker.*" A new song by Bryson Gray https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=iY77O_b5_AY Hilarious, very good; he's celebrating the homemakers, "*She's the queen, she's a teacher, she's a chef and baker.*"

She does so many incredible things for your tribe and for your community, but you can't just leave her in the house all day long and make her go nuts. Do you understand? She needs time to connect with you who are the king and the priest of your family. Amen! It doesn't matter whether you're busy or not, you make TIME!

In Korea under Father

When we were in Cheon Bok Gung and Father had me in charge of six world organizations, I had to do all those political meetings, I had to do all the social activity; I had to do all of that and then all the meetings and all that crap for all the organizations. Kook J-Hyung too; Kook J-Hyung was working 20-21-hour days every day. He was running back and forth between Korea and Japan taking care of twenty-seven businesses in Korea and a whole bunch of business groups in Japan. He was managing over three-billion-dollar worth of assets and flying literally every week from Korea to Japan. And he was not being paid; he didn't even take a pay

check. He was like Donald Trump; he didn't take a dang paycheck. And of course, he had to come back to the US to make sure his business was not floundering because he was running his business here too.

But when in Cheon Bok Gung and Father made me head of the six organizations, we were doing 20 -21-hour days. I had to lead the 2:30 training with all the Hoonsa-nims in the morning; I got to lead the public Hoon Dok Hae at five in the morning as well. We also had to actually climb a dang mountain for that training. So we were out on the dang outdoors; we got to climb the mountain every day at 2: 30 in the morning and then I got to lead the prayer, the meditation training up there. Kim Hoonsa-nim, and Cho Hoonsa-nim here, they did it EVERY DAY! Do you understand? Then at five in the morning we had Hoon Dok Hae, and on Sundays we had services all throughout the morning. On working days, nine o'clock was when the meetings began and all that kind of craziness. Since it was normal working-day hours, it was nine to five; that's when I had to do the political meetings and meet this and that politician. Kook J-Hyung was meeting the congressmen and we had to meet the religious leaders, etc. That was all the way till the evening time and then we were doing family visits until 10-11 at night, and the next morning the same thing over again.

And still I did the days of my children, but I didn't see them a lot during the day because the schedule was so insane. It was really a schedule that every CEO has to have. As anybody who's in charge of an organization, basically you have to run one hundred hours a week; that's just standard. So, it wasn't special in that category of people, but there was not a lot of time for my family. However, every week we did our days with our kids and it was not just group time it was one-on-one time; that was critical. We still have so many memories of the different places we went to; whether it be getting spaghetti or Chinese food, or whatever. They still remember that in Korea while we were busy.

Love & Respect

So, there's really no excuse; really no excuse. It's just one appointment per week with one of your children. You have to think of it as an appointment, and don't break it; it's a critical investment in your family. And then of course your spousal date training, you got to do that. Why? Because your wife is at home doing the homemaker; she's the culture changer, she's the culture maker, she's being the queen, she's being the teacher, she's homeschooling kids so they don't get brainwashed by Satan; she's the chef and baker. She's doing ALL that stuff that you would see in a neighborhood, but she's doing that at home. So once a week she needs to have a break from that. You understand? She needs a break; she needs a psychological and mental health break. You understand, folks? She can't be on this time clock 24/7. It's going to drive her nuts.

That's why it's critical for you as a king and priest to take her out of that environment. That's why grandmas and grandpas in your community are so important. You ask the grandmas and

grandpas who already have grown-up children; you give them ten bucks or you organize something with them, and you say, *"Hey, can you watch the kids for maybe two hours, and we'll be back; we just got to have a date real quick."* Are you with me, folks? That's not hard at all. That's why you got a community and you support one another. Amen! And pray for one another.

For your wife's mental health, for your wife's sanity, you have to take her out like that and she's able to feel romanced again, to feel loved and appreciated because the emotional realm for females is very important, is huge; that's how they communicate. That's why when God commands the man to love the wife unconditionally, you have to communicate emotionally with her, even though we don't want to do that. And vice versa, God commands women to respect the husband unconditionally because when you want to change your husband you don't do it emotionally by crying and acting emotional. No, you have to do it RATIONALLY and with respect; then they feel respected and they will change. It's pretty easy for them to change if you do that properly and not cry.

Don't cry, don't use the leverage of crying. The leverage of crying is a bad technique, girls; bad, bad, bad. It will come to bite you in the end; I guarantee you. You're going to make your husband angry. In the twenty years of crying when you use leverage to win arguments and make him submit, trust me you were destroying your marriage. Don't do that! When you explain something to your husband and you need something brought up; don't cry. And keep your time; if you promise twenty minutes, keep on time. Also don't just toss it to him as soon as he comes in, *"We need to talk now!"* Don't do that kind of childish stuff. Make an appointment as the Queen always teaches; see if he is busy, if he's in a mental space to be able to talk to you right now. Maybe he's dealing with all sorts of crazy crap and he's kind of freaking killing himself because he's two hundred thousand dollars in debt to some mob boss in freaking South Korea. I don't know what it is! You understand what I'm saying? You got to wait for him to be in the right mental space for that. Are you with me, girls?

You got to be wise; don't be foolish. Make sure if it is a serious talk, you say, *"Honey, can I talk with you tomorrow at eight and I promise twenty or thirty minutes?"* Don't go over thirty minutes otherwise in a man's world, if you break your promise in terms of time you've now lied; you've lied even though you don't feel it's a lie but you've lied. So, don't do that; always finish early. Simple things, simple things, very simple kindergarten-level stuff; easy to know, easy to actualize.

The Queen is showing me the Bible. Did we get to the Scripture yet? We are in 1 Peter chapter 5. But that's very important, very important, and actually 1 Peter 5 is about that, which is amazing. 1 Peter chapter 5; it's a very short chapter and we can read it together.

1 Peter 5: 1-11

¹The elders which are among you I exhort, who am also an elder, and a witness of the sufferings of Christ, and also a partaker of the glory that shall be revealed:

²Feed the flock of God which is among you, taking the oversight thereof, not by constraint, but willingly; not for filthy lucre, but of a ready mind;

³Neither as being lords over God's heritage, but being examples to the flock.

⁴And when the chief Shepherd shall appear, ye shall receive a crown of glory that fadeth not away.

⁵Likewise, ye younger, submit yourselves unto the elder. Yea, all of you be subject one to another, and be clothed with humility: for God resisteth the proud, and giveth grace to the humble.

⁶Humble yourselves therefore under the mighty hand of God, that he may exalt you in due time:

⁷Casting all your care upon him; for he careth for you.

⁸Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil, as a roaring lion, walketh about, seeking whom he may devour:

⁹Whom resist stedfast in the faith, knowing that the same afflictions are accomplished in your brethren that are in the world.

¹⁰But the God of all grace, who hath called us unto his eternal glory by Christ Jesus, after that ye have suffered a while, make you perfect, stablish, strengthen, settle you.

¹¹To him be glory and dominion for ever and ever. Amen.

¹²By Silvanus, a faithful brother unto you, as I suppose, I have written briefly, exhorting, and testifying that this is the true grace of God wherein ye stand.

Church Hopping

This is all about the community, praying and being humble to one another. We've talked about this many times: it's not wise to burn bridges quickly, not wise. Don't be that liability for your children. If you got a hot temper and you have a habit of burning bridges and running away you can tell by your life habits; you can tell if you honestly look at your life habit and how maybe you've run around and moved around. I've seen families, they start in this community and in one or two years they're gone, and they've done this their whole life. They've been going to different churches. It's not only Unificationists; this happens in a lot of the Christian churches too. They are hopping churches. Why?

In their mind they want to be the loving servant. They over-exert themselves, they do too much, don't get enough accolade for what they're doing, get angry, bitter and resentful and run away to another church, and then repeat that scenario again. These are people that are not watching their behavior; they're not analyzing their historical behavior; they're not taking any time. You have no coaches above you, no elders above you trying to help you analyze your past habits. Don't be that person! If you've been church hopping the last twenty years of your life, don't be that person; you got to be aware that it is a bad habit. You jump to the new church and then,

"I've done so much for this new church." You volunteered for the food kitchen, and you volunteered for this and that. And everybody's, *"Wow! This new family is so wonderful; they volunteer for everything."* But how long will it last? Are you with me? You got to pace yourself. Don't try to impress people! You have to know your limits; you have to know what you're capable of doing and you have to have the long-haul view.

Father says that a farmer is wise because he can see far away. Father sometimes says that Korean farmers have small eyes which means they're squinting all the time, so they're looking far away. You got to have a long-term view; you've got to be looking towards the horizon, not just for now. *"I come into this community and I need to impress everybody."* No, no, no! Don't do that! I've seen so much of it. It leads to burnout, it leads to that person failing and then feeling unappreciated, underappreciated, etc., and then everybody else is upset because, *"Hey, you're the one who volunteered for all this stuff. We didn't force you to do this."* You see, you're repeating a pattern; DON'T do that! Take it slow; be aware of the pattern.

Don't Burn Bridges

As adults, parents and grandparents it's very important to be aware of these patterns. If you have a pattern of breaking relationships and burning bridges quickly, that's a huge liability for your children. Do you understand? In the future nobody's going to want to marry your children because the parents are nuts. Don't be those parents. Is that true?

I mean everybody's going to think about their in-laws and if you as their parents are nuts and you're fighting with everybody, it doesn't matter how wonderful your children are; you're giving them a liability. Don't do that! This hyper individualistic Western mindset is corrosive to the family; you are not just an individual. Your constitutional rights are based on the individual but you yourself are not just an individual; you're connected to a network. Maybe you have children and a wife and then you have a community; now you have a tribe. No man is an island. You have to be aware of your patterns of behavior for the last twenty, thirty, forty years and OWN up to it. If there are bad points you have to admit they're bad and get rid of them; if there are good points you keep those. That's how you keep growing. Amen!

That's self-reflexivity or the ability to analyze yourself is very important; it's a critical muscle that most people do not have or exercise. Dean Radtke's program calls it "time on the mountain." <https://truthandliberty.net/bio/dean-radtke/> If you're a leader you need time on the mountain, you need time away from people; you need time to reflect on the different things. And it's not only for a leader; it's for every man. Especially since you're the king and priest of your household, you have to have time to reflect on yourself to keep purging the bad habits, keep purging the stupid stuff and build up the good stuff. That's why it's so important to be around whom? People that are good examples.

Studying Under Business Black-Belt Kook Jin Nim

Let's go back to **verse 3**:

³ Neither as being lords over God's heritage, but being examples to the flock.

Be an example to your brother. That doesn't mean you have to control him like a slave. No! But you have to be a good example; if you're a good example then he's willing to listen because you already are black belt in whatever topic he's talking about. Nobody's going to listen to some bozo who thinks he knows about everything. Everybody knows those kinds of people; they want to be the expert on everything. You know you're a white belt on that topic; you shouldn't be talking about that. The people who are not self-reflexive they think they can talk on every topic and be black belt. That's simply not true.

One of the biggest things that we did when we were doing ministry in Korea was Kook Jin Nim basically opened up his whole executive time. We would go to him on Tuesdays and I would just watch him; I would watch him run twenty-seven businesses every Tuesday. I would literally just sit there at the table watching him run and manage. I knew nothing about organization; nothing, zero. I had just graduated from the school of divinity where I had been studying theology, so I was just a brain-dead idiot in terms of organizational management, zero, zero, not even white belt. But I was sitting under Kook Jin Nim who's a black belt in that realm.

All the influential leaders of Korea put our Korean business group in the top 50. It was never even on the top 200; it was not even on the top list at all. In a couple of years, we got in the top 50 just because of Kook J-Hyung's leadership. Of course, we'd be in the top 5 of all the businesses in Korea right now if the Han mother hadn't fallen, but that's a whole other story.

The point is: he operated with all these new guys coming in from LG and Samsung; all these new guys who had heard that the Unification Church were brain-dead dummies when it came to managing organizations and you could rob them blind. This was the rumor mill that was going around because so many people would come in, they'd work with a Unification Church business, funded by the church by the way, and they'd rob it blind. The level of our leadership was PATHETIC in terms of business.



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Kook Jin Nim actually ran a business; he actually created something from nothing. He started at Shot Show; he got four thousand orders the first day he went to Shot Show, and started with this little four-foot table there.

Because of his invention of the Kahr 9 pistol, he got four thousand orders IN A DAY at that first Shot Show and then he built it up from that to be one of the biggest in the industry. He has the gift of doing that.

So, he came in and was managing the businesses, and all these incompetent church leaders, all there politically, they were doing a ruckus; they were trying to get him fired at every single step. They were trying to hide their corruption and he was auditing them. He helped us put in

those programs in the church side as well so the ministers could not steal; the ministers and the churches were audited.

The point is: he had tremendous knowledge in that field of managing organizations and managing high-level professionals. These guys were coming in from LG and Samsung, lawyers and accountants, top-level people in Korea, top-level lawyers that had networks into the top judges, and every network in Korea. He was bringing them into the foundation.

I would see it on Tuesdays. New top-level lawyers would come in, Korean national-level lawyers would come in. They would say this and that about the organization and he'd just pick them apart. He'd say, *"What about this percentage? What about that percentage? I want this, I want that."* And they'd say, *"Holy crash! This dude knows what he's doing! This is not like the old UC leadership which we could rob!"* You understand? They were like, *"Oh yes, Chairman, we will come back with that analysis next week. Yes Sir!"* You understand? They couldn't play around because he knew the game; he was a black belt in that game, in that landscape.

I watched him for years and learned bit by bit just watching him; I'm nowhere near black belt. But I watched him run and manage these organizations and make these executive decisions, etc.; which is very difficult. If you make the wrong executive decision your organization tanks. That's how critical that leader is. The executive is that crass and they get paid big bucks, even though he wasn't paid anything. But that's why you're supposed to pay the executive big bucks, because he makes the critical decisions for the organization and if he makes the wrong decisions, the whole thing crashes; all those jobs are lost and all those families are out.

I watched him do that for several years; every Tuesday I watched him run that. I learned SO much! It was unbelievable; I learned incredible things just watching him. Just from watching a high-level black-belt executive making executive decisions and preventing the organization from being robbed and hoodwinked by potential swindlers, etc. Watching this was incredible! It was incredible; such an AMAZING experience! It built up a skill set which was totally non-existent.

Now, if I was full of ego about it, I could have said, *"I have all the positions, Father gave me all the positions; I'm his successor. I don't need to learn that business stuff."* I could have been arrogant like that. But no! Ten years of meditation and constant self-reflexivity training; ten years of meditation training, 10,000 hours plus of constantly looking not out of emotion, but constantly analyzing yourself, that muscle helped me develop that organizational understanding at least on the blue-belt level. Maybe I'm blue belt; I don't know. You can ask Kook Jin Nim. I'm not black belt, but I'm not white belt; I'm not a white belt now after ten years of this.

So, the point is: every king and priest, you have to build up on those weaknesses. But if you're not analyzing yourself and you're just doing the grind; if you're just trying to get into a pattern and grind so you don't have to think about it; if you go to work, come home, watch TV, go to sleep, go to work, come home, watch TV, you're going to WRECK your FAMILY. Are you with me, folks? You're going to wreck it! Your wife's mental health is going to plummet; she's going

to go nuts. Your KIDS are going to go nuts, and they're going to hate you. Because even though you made money, I don't care how many big bucks you make, if they feel neglected and they don't feel you put any time into them you're an a-hole. It doesn't matter how much money you give them. If it's big enough money, they'll probably just rob you, just steal it from you and just treat you nicely in front of your face. But is that the type of relationship you want to have with your children? NO! No, no, no! That's FAKE! Fakery, all fakery. They're TOOLING you! All your emphasis cannot be just about making money.

Now, you have to make money. The Bible says a husband that does not provide for his family is worse than an unbeliever someone who does not believe in Christ, *"But if anyone does not provide for his own, and especially for those of his household, he has denied the faith and is worse than an unbeliever."* (1 Timothy 5:8) So, it is part of your responsibility but it's not your only job, you understand? Provider is not your only job.

Training for Priesthood

What are the other two Ps? Priest and Protector, right? That's why the priesthood is so important. As a man you have to also be interested in developing your priestly understanding; which means what? You have to study THEOLOGY and philosophy. Why is that important? Because when your kids get to teenage years, they're going to start CHALLENGING you and they're going to become cultural atheists because it's more convenient. If they're cultural atheists they can have sex and run around with whomever they want to play with, boys and all this kind of crap. Do you understand? So, they're incentivized to want to become atheists and they have a whole community and the world that tells them to do that, *"Don't be oppressed by your Christian parents."* Are you with me, folks?

You'd better be aware of that. When they become teens, they're going to be cultural atheists in your home and they're not going to all have the gift of faith. Some of your kids will have the gift of faith; that is one of the spiritual gifts in the Bible. But some of them will not, and some of them will be full of doubts. For example, myself, I did not have the gift of faith. I was skeptical; I was a cultural agnostic into Buddhism and stuff like that. So, I did not have the gift of faith. Don't EVER assume that since you and your wife had the gift of faith, your children will have it. You are a ONE MILLION percent wrong! Are you with me, folks? ONE MILLION percent wrong, one MILLION percent wrong. Do NOT make that RIDICULOUS kindergarten mistake! You could have the greatest faith in the world, but your kids are probably going to be opposite.

So, now you have to PREPARE because when they become teenagers that's when you're going to be critically important to guide them through with priestly knowledge. That means you have to have theological knowledge; you have to have ministerial knowledge; you have to be able to know to counsel your children. Because they're going to be so sensitive at that time too, that if you do it too hard, they're going to hate you and never want to see you for the next twenty years. So, you got to do it in the right balance of honesty, and it's hard enough, but also you got

to be sensitive to their weak emotional feelings in their teenage years, especially when they're convinced that cultural atheism and free sex is RIGHT and they want to DO it. Are you with me, folks? So, you got to have that good balance.

How are you going to do that if you're not training? You got to be training, you got to be studying theology. That's why Hoon Dok Hae is important. Don't be cranking out the Bible every day and only reading mechanically like, *"Oh, okay, that's it!"* No, but also studying it. When you're driving to work, etc., listen to podcasts on Scripture, listen to theology. Instead of wasting your time on this and that, you're studying for your priesthood because you're going to need it. I guarantee you're going to need it when your kids are in their teens. Watch, watch, watch! You are going to need a strong dose of mental theology. The pastor is not going to do it. They don't want to hear from the pastor, they don't want to hear from anyone; they want to hear it from DAD. They live with you, you're the kingdom priest of your household; they want to hear it from YOU. It's not something you can outsource. You can outsource it to some degree but not fully; you have to have some control into explaining to cultural atheists WHY you believe in Jesus and True Father. If you do not have that ABILITY, you won't be able to witness your kids.

How do you get that ability? Well, you got to train, you got to train. As the Bible says right here in 1st Peter 5: you have to be an example; *"Don't just be a lord over God's heritage."* Don't just use your position like, *"I'm your father and mother, you obey what I say!"* That works when your kids are really young; not teenagers though. *"I believe this faith; you have to believe it too!"* Uh, good luck with that! I guarantee you probably have 90% failure; 90% of your kids are going to go to Satan.

That's not how you evangelize ANYBODY! You would NEVER witness a new member that way; never, never, never, never. You would NEVER evangelize somebody like that. Why do you do it to your children? It doesn't work; it's a failed, failed, failed method. If you evangelize somebody even who's new, you are praying for them, you are caring for them. Any questions, you're not taking emotionally, you're taking seriously; you're trying to answer in a polite and loving way because you want their soul to be saved. Hey! You got to also do that with your kids when they become teens. You can't just stuff it in and say, *"This is what Daddy and Mommy believe; this is what you believe."* It won't work; that's not how Christianity works, that's not how faith works; especially when they don't have the gift of faith which many of the kids do not have, and it's not their fault. It's not their fault; it's there for a reason. Some people don't have the gift of faith because they've been given other gifts.

So, you have to be future-looking. When you have an investor mindset, you have to be investing for the future; you're not investing for tomorrow and the next day. You're looking at future road, you're looking at future trends, you're looking at future patterns, and then you're making decisions that will protect your assets over the long run. Well, if you do that for your money and you're not doing it for your family or your children or your wife, you're being a terrible priestly investor; especially to the key assets that God has given YOU. YOU are going to

have to live with these folks and of course in the spirit world too; these are the relationships you take. This is a critical, critical, critical asset that God has given you. Amen!

It's something that requires training. Being around mature individuals, being around people who know how to do this already. They say, *"If you have five millionaire friends and you're around them all the time, you will become the sixth millionaire."* What does that mean? The study shows this: the five people you spend the most time with influence your personality the most; you literally become an amalgamation of the five people you hang around with the most.

So, you have to be hanging around people who are good examples. Not everybody is going to be high level in everything, right? Some people may be really good with their family but they're not so good in business; that's why you need to have a balance of friends. You need to have some friends who are good in business and know how to make money; other friends that are very good in raising their family. Then you'll take the good parts of each and you eliminate the bad parts which you have inside. That's how you learn; you keep growing that way. Are you with me, folks?

That's why training is so important and preparing early, that means decades in advance, is the smartest way; you want to prepare decades in advance. You know some of your kids will become cultural atheists by the time they're teens; some of them, not all; some of them. The ones that are not gifted with faith they will become cultural atheists. They will say, *"Well Dad, I don't even believe in that; there's no evidence for that, blah, blah, blah, etc."* There are a lot of studies that they'll be challenging you that way. How are you going to respond to that? You have the gift of faith, they're now saying they don't believe in it, so how are you going to respond? You're going to get upset; you're going to say, *"I'm going to cut ties with you,"* or whatever. What are you going to do?

They're testing you. They may have some faith, they may have faith as small as a mustard seed, but how you react may kill that seed. Maybe some kids, they don't want to believe in God at all because they want to do free-sex culture; they want to be prostitutes and harlots. You're going to have some of those, sure. But some of them who are testing their parents, they just want the parents to give them a reason to kill the seed of faith, the tiny seed of faith that they have, *"Just give me a reason Dad or Mom, come on! I'm going to provoke you. Give me a reason to leave all this crap and all these "rules" that God made."* And you'll be the one to give them that reason if you're not ready to talk to them like a new member.

You see, it's hard, it's emotional because they're your baby and you've seen them growing from diapers and barfing on you when they were a child, and now they're at this age and you want the best for them. You want them to believe in God and all the great things that this will give them. BUT they DON'T want it! So, it's so emotional; it's so hard to treat them like a new member.

Godly Father-Daughter Relationship

I teach the fathers, *"As dads, don't get played by your girls! Young dads, don't get played by your daughters. Your daughters will manipulate you, not because they're bad; it's just how kids do."* They know that Daddy has a very soft spot for his daughter. They know that, so they will play that like a flute. You understand? They will play it like a flute. They'll cry; they'll use every technique they have to manipulate you. Again, it's not because they're bad; they're just trying to use any leverage they have as a female. They know Daddy's affection for his daughter is very, very, strong compared to his boys. So, you have to be aware of this. One of the hardest things for the father is to reprimand and be honest with his daughter and not cater to her feelings. That's one of the hardest things to do, honestly. HARDEST! HARDEST! It's easier to say no to your boys, but to your daughter as she gets older and she looks just like her mom and you, and it's like, *"Oh my gosh, my little baby girl,"* the man becomes mushy. *"What the hell is going on?"* All of a sudden, the man is mush; all of a sudden, he's freaking mashed potatoes. What the heck's wrong with that boy?

It HAPPENS! I'm telling you; it happens. It happens if you're not aware. If you're not aware they will play you like a fiddle. I tell you, when I was raising my daughter, the hardest thing was to tell her honestly- I don't want to do it; maybe Mom can do it, etc. - Just to tell honestly, *"No, this is a stupid decision; this is dumb. Don't do that!"* or *"This is not good for you,"* or *"This is wiser,"* etc. Telling her straight the way I told my boys, it was very hard in terms of emotions. But I am stronger than my emotions so even though it was hard, I DID it. That's why the girl has rational faculties; she can actually think because Daddy didn't follow his emotions. I'm still very loving, I'm still emotional BUT I'm not RULED by it.

For example, she's quite a good fighter; even though she says she's not, she's actually quite good. As a teacher I see it. She has very good athletic abilities; she's armbar girl. I'm not trying to embarrass her here, but this is a lesson for the whole community. When she started fighting, the first time she had to fight other girls, it was rough because you get beat up and girls frequently cry. Males frequently cry when they start the combat arts; it's very normal even for males to cry after training because they get so demoralized and humiliated and beat up. You're nowhere near what you thought you were, and you got that put in your face and everybody saw it too. The point is: it's very frequent, it's very normal.

So, my baby was training and I was sitting right there guiding them and she looked up at Daddy- she was 11-12 years old - she was looking up at Daddy and she was crying while she was fighting the girl, like, *"Save me Daddy!"* Did I jump in and beat up the girl? NO! I said, *"Focus, focus! Focus, focus! Left hand out, left hand out, elbow in, elbow in, push, shrimp, shrimp!"* You see what I did? I did not bow to the emotion. That's critical because I was teaching her a critical value: *"Don't manipulate men with emotional stuff. You can't do that with Daddy even though Daddy is very mushy towards you."*

The boys, they all know this, so whenever they want to ask Daddy, "Can we go get ice-cream or can we go snowboarding or skiing etc.?" when they want to ask a favor from Daddy, they're going to send their sister. They all get together and they freaking send their sister because they know she got the mushy-mushy power over Daddy sometimes. But I'm aware of it. Do you understand? So, they can't play me like a fiddle. Sometimes I will LET them have the request that they did through their sister to get what they want, especially if it's a small request like Dorito chips or some stupid stuff like that.

The point is: kids do this, folks; you understand? They try to play you, not because they're bad; it's just that they're trying to gain maximum leverage for what they want as they're growing. So, girls will do that game to the daddy especially if they have a good heart and they're soft. Oh man, your daughter is going to tug on you like Goliath, but you can't succumb to it. If you succumb to it, you'll be a terrible priest; you're being a bad priest, bad king. That doesn't mean when she asks for ice cream sometimes you don't give it. No, no! But don't let her get into the habit of knowing she can play Daddy because that's going to come to kill you when she becomes a teen. You understand what I'm saying? It's going to kill you. Don't build that muscle. You think it's cute when they're seven or eight years old and they're manipulating Daddy a little bit so they can get an extra ice cream; how cute! NOT cute when they are fifteen and sixteen. But you didn't curb that bad behavior when they were young; you didn't act as the PRIEST! If you thought it was cute, it's going to come to bite you later.

The point is: you got to be thinking forward, forward, forward, when you're raising kids. You have to be thinking future; what is the best for them? For me it would be nice if I'm always just nice to my daughter and she just loves Daddy and whatever she wants I can give her. I feel like "Oh, I'm such a good dad." I mean I'm not giving her any good feedback. I am not being a good priest to her and setting boundaries and limitations on her desire; not training or teaching her that "you can't have this or that because this will be deleterious to you etc." This is when she's younger.

Those kinds of things are so important but you have to be thinking of these things in advance, because they come back to haunt you when they become teens. Of course, there's no guarantee; again, there's no guarantee. You can do everything right but there's no guarantee, no guarantee. So, you have to pray; obviously you've got to pray during the whole time. (*Laughing*) That's what kids make you do; they make you pray. They definitely make you pray, and again you have to have faith that God is leading you through it. BUT you got to do your five percent to your maximum ability.

"Don't Be as a Lord over God's Heritage but Be an Example to the Flock."

You got to try to set the right example as it says in verse 3. You got to not only try to rule over God's heritage but you have to set the right example. If you want to give them good habits, if you want to teach them how a mature adult behaves, well it's important that they see how you

behave; in the HOME, not only outside dealing with people. In the home; how do you behave in the home. Are you fine outside, but when you come home, you're yelling? Are you fine outside but when you come home, you're crying all the time to get what you want; that's girls and men and women. Kids will see you when you come back home; they're now watching you when you come home. Are you with me, folks? That's why you need to be an example and that's where this whole attitude of TRAINING is so important because **training is something you do whether you like it or not.**

When you get back from a long day and you're right about to go into your home, as a man and king and priest you take five minutes in your car to thank God for the day even though you got into ten fights; it doesn't matter. You thank God for ten of those fights, plus everything else He's done for you that day. You thank Him for the family that you're about to see; you thank Him for the wife you're about to kiss. You take five minutes of meditation training in that car to collect yourself before you enter that environment. How simple is that? That would be a good habit. If every man did that in the world, that would be an amazing habit that would save a lot of relationships probably; just that small habit of five minutes before you walked in that door.

Why would you do that? Well, you do that because you are taking seriously the job of being a priest when you walk into that sanctuary which is your home; you are actually taking it seriously. It's not just something you do on Sunday, or when you hear it being preached you say, "HALLELUJAH! Amen!" No, no! It's actually something you do in your priestly role as the father at home. It's something you as a priest are taking seriously when you are now about to enter the sanctuary which is your home; that's your family-level church and sanctuary.

How many people like it when their pastor before they enter the church or before they go to work say a prayer, "Thank You Father for all the things..." Everybody loves that when their pastor or their priest does it. Why wouldn't your children and your wife like it, if before you come in to see them you are praying and thanking God for everything that's happened and you're thanking God for all the people there and asking God for wisdom to be a good leader when you step in that family-level sanctuary? Why would you think your kids and wife won't appreciate that? They will appreciate that. Why? Because you're taking a little bit of time to collect yourself and take your job seriously.

"DO YOUR JOB!" is what you're always learning as a man. "DO YOUR JOB!" Well, that's not only at the workplace. What about when you come home? That's a king's and a priest's job; that's a job given to you by God. All the workplace stuff is given by men. God is giving you the job of being a king and priest; that's literally divine work. So, if you like the old adage, "Do your job," DO YOUR JOB! in your home sanctuary. If you love that, repeat it, "Do your job! Do your job!" That gets you motivated? "Do your job!" Be a good priest and be a good king. Bring in the culture of praise and thanksgiving i.e., gratitude, into your church. Bring in the culture of "Praise God for today. I got into ten fights today but God is good and He gave me wisdom for this and that, and I'm grateful to be able to be with you all tonight." (Laughing) Because they're your first

members so-to-speak; they're the people you have to raise up to be the next generation of kings and priests.

Now, if you do this as a MAN, not only do your job to the earthly workplace but you do it for the GODLY kingdom which is your family in your home, the people living there are going to be grateful that you're taking God seriously. And that doesn't mean just going to church on SUNDAY! This is the difference between Christianity New Testament and Completed Testament age. Father clarifies that we're not just praying; we have to **ATTEND GOD**. That means we're to **LIVE with HIM!** That means no fake love, no Sunday fake love. That means real *shish kebab*. You understand? That means: get it done, be an example, PUT the WORK in. It's not going to get you saved but the people you're leading are going to be THANKFUL for that work. Are you with me folks?

That's why this scripture is so important; it says, *"Be an example."*

³ Neither as being lords over God's heritage, but being examples to the flock" which is His people. We don't like the commies because they say our children are the state's property, and we say, *"NO! We don't like that; they're OUR property,"* but that's actually theologically incorrect; they're God's property. You understand? They're GOD's property, they're God's children. Yes, He put us as the parents over them, but again that's God's heritage. So, he said, *"Don't be as a lord over God's heritage but be an example to the flock."*

You want to be that example for your family, investing in your queen; investing in her mental health and taking her out once a week and connecting that ninety minutes of eye time so she doesn't go insane, drive the kids nuts and become a tyrant in the home. You want to invest in her mental health and spiritual health. You have to take her out; you have to pour into her. She's your evangelist; as a priest you have to pour into her. You have to have good memories together; you have to have time where you're praying over her and thanking God for the three gifts of gratitude. Remember we do that in the date training? We say three things we're grateful for, for one another and we give glory to God. Then the father as the priest prays over that and offers it up to True Father because we're attending True Father on that date; True Parents are with us on that date. Hello! We're training.

How AMAZING! What a blessing! The first generation got twenty-one years of fundraising as their gift; 24/7. Our generation is a JOKE! We got to DATE our WIFE! Give me a freaking break! We are so blessed, it's ridiculous! Are you kidding me? There's NO COMPLAINING that this is hard! This is a freaking joke! And you get a total blessing from it. You're not sacrificing your family, children and everything; you're actually building it. There's no freaking excuse if you've got a brain; there's NO dang excuse! It's so freaking easy and it's so beneficial; such a blessing!

That's why it's not only to lord over God's heritage but to tend to that flock. And your wife is key part of your ministry; she's the evangelist. She's going to be the main teacher over your children, especially when they're young. You have to pour into her; you have to arm her for that responsibility. So, you must take seriously the things of God and the things of faith. It could be

something as simple as you heading into work and you're listening to an exegesis on 1 Peter 5 or you're listening to the service once again. You know what I'm saying? It could be something as simple as that, but you're reinforcing the knowledge and the ideas in your brain, and then reinforcing them and then trying to practice them.

You start with baby steps because nobody's perfect; you start with baby steps and you start slow and every week you do your training and you get better as you go. Nobody's asking for you to be black belt when you begin; that's impossible. You're going to be a white belt and you need to do the same move over and over and fail and fail and do it over and over. It takes about two years to even get anything working in Jiu-Jitsu or combat; it takes about two years. But once you do, you start winning, and you start getting victories.

Now, the key point is to not give up during that two-year process when you're learning those new muscles, and to count your small victories. That's key, key, key! Not comparing yourself to black belt, no; small victories. *"Hey, I started taking my wife out on a date. We heard about that training and when I look at 2022, I did those eighteen times."* Okay, good; that's great! Some of you didn't do eighteen times and some of you did more, but you count that as a victory if it's better than the year before. *"This year I'm going to be more consistent; this year I'm going to make less excuses."*

Sometimes guys kind of forget about it for a month and then I'll ask,

"Hey y'all been doing your date training?"

-"Oh, I haven't been doing it."

"DO your training! Get your training done!"

When you're first doing it and building those muscles, you're lazy, you don't know what to do. It's not second nature so you forget and you don't think it's important and you neglect all those studies and all the evidence, and then you're right back to never doing it again. Then your wife's mental health is collapsing and you don't even know it. That's what you don't want to do. Amen!

That's why not only ruling with authority and *"this is my position so I could rule over you!"* No! Be a good example; we have to be good examples. It doesn't mean you're perfect; nobody's perfect but we can be higher-level than the people we're leading. As long as you're higher-level than the people you're leading they'll follow you; I'm talking about your family, right. As long as you are higher level than your children and if you're the husband, you're higher level in different things than your wife, she'll follow you because she wants to learn; as long as you're not haughty about it and just like a nut head or a bozo and you're humble about it but you're still higher level because you put the work in. It won't get you saved by the way, but the people you're leading will be appreciative of the work you put in. Critical, critical, critical, critical!

A Well-Balanced Training

So, remember when we are raising our kids, we're raising our grandkids; our kids are watching how we behave in public and private. Nobody likes those fake glitter-bug pastors who are in the big megachurch. They behave one way on the stage and behind the scenes they're sleeping with fifty whatever. You know what I'm saying? Or they're stealing this or that money. You know what I'm saying? Nobody likes that. Well, your children are going to be just as critical of you as you are of those kinds of glitter-bug pastors or preachers or Catholic priests - whatever it is. They're going to hate you as much; they're going to be more judgmental of you than you are of those people.

It doesn't mean you have to live in fear, but it means that it's a good impetus, it's a good motivational energy for you to increase your theological studies, your knowledge of the Bible, your knowledge of the Principle; to substantially actualize your training with your wife like spousal training, practicing outside together, doing the Rod of Iron training, going to Jiu- Jitsu class on Tuesdays and Wednesdays, etc. By doing these things which are annoying you're putting in the work, so that ten years later when the kids see you, you're a well-rounded man or woman; you are well-rounded physically and you're well-rounded mentally and intellectually; you're not just one-sided.

Your kids will generally either grow up intellectual or they'll grow up physically-oriented, so if husband and wife, you are very physical, you are rock climbing, you do Jiu-Jitsu every day, you're MMA fighters, your kids will probably HATE MMA and they'll hate rock climbing. That's how it works unless you bring them into it in a way they can digest it. They'll try to go just intellectual and they'll try to beat you intellectually and try to prove that you're an idiot for believing in God and for rock climbing and doing MMA. [Laughter] They'll probably do that, trying to beat you intellectually.

On the other hand, if you're just an intellectual bug and you're just always reading, you're just brainiac and you're like a skinny little thing, guess what? Your kids are probably going to build up their physicality so they can say, "F-you," and beat you up and say, "I don't need you; you stupid brainiac. I can do what I want. I'm going to be a strong man or woman." They're going to try to beat you physically. So, it's very important for the kings of Cheon Il Guk especially, to lead your family in both development of physical and intellectual. Intellectual includes theology, apologetics; physical includes combat arts, Rod of Iron Riders, Rod of Iron training. Why? Because you're showing them, "No, either way Daddy has control over the situation. I may not be the highest level in both but I have knowledge in both and whatever way you want to go, Daddy can still lead you in that way."

That doesn't mean one hundred percent they'll follow you if you have bad coaching or counseling skills. It's not only your skill set; you have to also be able to coach them properly. There are a lot of terrible coaches, not because they're bad wrestlers but because they don't know how to TEACH. There are other skills involved with the communication of those

traditions to your children theologically and physically, because the Kingdom is not only spiritual, it's also physical. There are critical things that one needs to be able to communicate and pass on to the next generation so they absorb it.

So, you have to be well balanced at least more well-rounded than you may be, which is the reason why you want to be around a community of people that are trying to become well-rounded spiritually, mentally, intellectually, physically. You want to be around those people so you are getting stimulated to build up the places where you have a deficit, and in the places where you're better, you're actually inspiring OTHER PEOPLE to build up the deficit they may have. Are you with me, folks? It works in a symbiotic relationship; which is again the reason why in the end no man is an island, no FAMILY is an island either.

Training in Apologetics for Evangelism

Remember you can't make your family your idol, because you've got to teach them to be good people, to *"love God, love your NEIGHBOR."* How are you teaching them to "love your NEIGHBOR" if they're not even loving the church brothers and sisters; if you're only focused on your family and you're not teaching them how to love brothers and sisters or your NEIGHBOR? So, again no family is an island; don't make family your idol. Everything has to be centered on God. But the reason why we have the desire to want to lead our family is in the end so that they, God willing, do their five percent and have a relationship with God. In the end that's every parent's wish. It should be, that's our desire; we want them to have a relationship with Christ. Amen! Critical!

That's why we invest in evangelism, that's why we invest in studying theology, that's why we invest in studying apologetics. Not because it may bring us a particular joy; it's actually quite dense and quite thick material to get through and sometimes it hurts your brain. BUT you do it because you love your kids. It may become a very important technical tool you need when they become cultural atheists and they want EVERY EXCUSE to be a free-sex harlot and a man slut, and you're literally the last obstacle in their way. So, you're like the silver bullet; you're the last chance they got before they wreck their life.

BUT because ten years before you heard a particular sermon and you got INSPIRED by the Holy Spirit and started studying and training in small increments and in ten years you've built up knowledge, ten years later now you can talk to your kids. And maybe because of that training you had and because of that investment you made, MAYBE you can stop them and help them make a better decision, a wiser decision so they won't wreck their life being a harlot and a man slut, but they'll be someone that THEY can be proud of, YOU can be proud of and GOD can bring proud of. Amen! You see what I'm saying?

Who knows? Who knows? You never know how training's going to help play out. That's why training is so important. You don't only train martial arts BECAUSE you're going to fight; you

train it because when you need it, it's too late; you train it in advance of getting beat up. There are a lot of people who get beat up and then go into martial arts because they already had the experience of being beat up. But you don't have to do that; you don't have to get beat up in order to train self-defense. You can start even though you have not been beaten up; you can start for the FUTURE when you may need it.

See? Same thing! Why would you study apologetics? You already have faith, you already believe in God, your wife believes in God; you already come to church on Sundays. Uh-uh, no, no, no, but your kids are going to become cultural atheists and Satan is going to witness them to be free-sex harlots and man sluts to wreck their life and wreck the lineage and become his children. So, you're not studying apologetics for YOUR enjoyment; you're doing something for ten years down the road where your kids may need it. Are you with me folks? You may be that very last resource they come to before they jump off the edge and wreck their life.

There's no guarantee of course but you have a higher percentage; if you are ready for that situation, you have a higher percentage. It doesn't mean you're going to win 100%; there's no guarantee of any winning 100% in ANYTHING in life, but you can raise your percentage. Amen! If you do not do these things, guess what? When your kids have issues of faith, existential crisis, they're contemplating suicide, they want to do this and that, you CAN'T help them. You're a nobody! I don't care how much money you got; you're a nobody to them. You suck, you're terrible, you're useless, you're evil; they won't care about what you have.

That's why it's important to train early, early, early, before this happens; very, very, important. Not because you're guaranteed to win, no. It's like an insurance; you're preempting potential hazard. You're increasing your percentage of succeeding and getting through potential disaster. That's what a smart man and wise man does. That's why God encourages us to go to the Word and to study and obtain wise knowledge and have good wise counsel.

Protect God's Lineage, God's Property

1 Peter 5 is so important. Why? It says it right there:

³ Neither as being lords over God's heritage, but being examples to the flock.

⁴ And when the chief Shepherd shall appear, ye shall receive a crown of glory that fadeth not away.

Why is God going to give you a crown of glory? Is it because you made fifty or sixty thousand, hundred thousand dollars a year? Is that why you're going to get a crown of glory? Then Bill Gates should get ten thousand. That's not the reason why God's going to give you a crown of glory. Christ is not going to give you a crown of glory because you went and bought a big house and you bought your wife cars and you send your kids to private school; you're not going to get a crown of glory for that.

Why is Christ going to give you a crown of glory? Because you've been loyal to His flock, to His property; our children are not only our children, they're God's property. So, are we being loyal

to God's desire for His property, OR are we treating them as OUR property? Huh? Are you with me, folks? The state wants to own them as ITS property, parents want to own them as THEIR property; God's saying, *"What about me, you bozos?"* Doesn't GOD get a VOICE in THIS? God is saying, *"WHAT ABOUT ME, you BOZOS? They are MY property!"* Ah, okay! But people of God should know that; they shouldn't need the pastor to have to yell at them about that. And it's exactly the point; people don't know that.

We forget; we have to do what is most important for God. What did Father say? What's the most important between love, life and lineage? More than life, more than love, lineage is. Father himself delineated what is most important for Christ; it's lineage. What does that mean? Our lineage is not ours; not our property. This is God's property; this is True Father's property. Our children are True Parents' property, meaning we have to raise them in a way which gives them joy.

They can make big, big, bucks outside but they could be sleeping with the Devil; I guarantee you True Father's not going to be happy about that. You could have sent them to all the expensive after school programs in Korea; moms do that a lot. You could have done all that and now they're Satan's children. So, what, they're making money? They hate God; they don't even believe in Christ. How is that as Father's property? How does he feel about how you handle his investment? He's pretty pissed about it.

That's why we got to change our mindset. They're definitely not the state's property, that's communism, but they're not just the parents' property if you believe in God and if you know the Creator. They're God's property. That's why we have to evangelize them at some time; we can't just force faith on them. It doesn't work, it doesn't; trust me, it doesn't work. I've seen it; it fails. It works through counseling and evangelizing, praying for them and trying to convince them, and you don't know whether they're going to accept it or not.

That's the hard part because you don't want to see your kids become Satan's children but that's always a risk. So, you have to rely on God, but you have to counsel them, you have to evangelize them to the best of your ability. You have to work with them so that they at one point hopefully can proclaim their faith in God. And even if they're not sure about it, well, you have patience just as you would with any other person you're evangelizing. Amen! You have patience, you keep praying for them, you keep interacting with them, you keep trying to share your faith in skillful ways; you keep trying to open that door. Are you with me folks?

These are very important skills to practice well. So, we have to be around those kinds of people who do that well. At least among some of the people that you're close with, you have to have people who are skillful at that; that's how you learn how to do it more skillfully. You won't learn how to be a better counselor by being around Bill Gates or Jeff Bezos, but you'll learn how to be a better counselor by being near for example a high-level minister. Many times, they're very good counselors because they counsel people in the faith a lot. So maybe that's one of your key friends; you'll learn how to be a good counselor from this pastor friend or minister friend or

an elder in a church. You understand what I'm saying? He has a specific skill set which is going to be very important for your small church as a family. You want to include that in your key relationships.

But then at the same time that pastor or priest or counselor, they don't know how to make money at all; they're terrible at that. So, you want to be around people that know how to make money too; you also want a friend like that so you can learn stuff from him. You see, because people have different gifts.

When you do that then you, as a leader, are increasing your ability in different realms, and that has a direct impact on the people you're leading, and if you're married and have kids and family, you're already supposed to be leading them. Not just providing; you have to be the priest, provider, protector. That is the responsibility of a man. Amen!

Critical relationship! And it's fun; it's fun once we get used to it. At first the muscles are hard to grow, but once you have them and they're bigger, it's fun to work them out. It's enjoyable, it gets fun, it becomes a joy; it's no longer a chore, it's no longer something foreign and hard. Now as second nature it's easy; it's fun. AND you get all the benefits! It gets easier as long as you work hard at it, and you get the same number of benefits if not more because now you're more skilled at it.

Such blessings! Such blessings! Father has blessed us with the "Age of Liberation and Complete Release"! Look at all these little babies running around here; look at this, look at this! You understand? Look at all these kids, everybody; they're all going to be cultural atheists in their teenage years. Look around! All these kids are going to be cultural atheists. What will you do? Don't just think, "*Oh, well, the pastor is going to train them all.*" NO! I AM NOT! YOU are going to train them! You are the first priest line. That's why it's critical. "*Oh, the Third King, he's going to be doing ministry. He will train them.*" NO! HE WON'T! We'll only be doing supportive work but the main homework has to be done by whom? The head of the home, the priest, and the wife, the evangelist.

Now, you're going to get training, you're going to get support, you're going to interact with other priests and other evangelists; you'll be supporting one another and you're getting connected with True Father's Kingship and culture and Constitution. All that is community. But in the end, look at all these little babies running around; in ten years they are going to be cultural atheists. You see what I'm saying?

That's why we got to do the classes, that's why we got to do the study and the training, so when they do become that way - which is not their fault by the way; they live in a satanic world that's brainwashing them constantly; it's not even their fault - but when they do become that way, we're ready; at least better prepared than if we didn't practice and train AT ALL. At least you're SOMEWHAT more prepared ten years down the road than if you had no training. So, you have a higher percentage of being the catalyst for saving your children's life from jumping off into

Satan's land and staying in God's Kingdom. You can literally save their life, spiritual life, mental life, and physical life because getting into drugs and all that crap

And moms too, evangelist training. Get your training, get in the training with the Queen; get in on the queen training, get in on the parenting training, get in on that training. There's a reason why the Queen is working so hard to train up the girls. You got to take advantage of that tremendous resource. Now she's training up other sisters that are going to be teaching that and spreading it, because she can't teach all the classes especially for a growing community. There's a reason why those exist; not so that you can pretend you're taking the classes, but so that you can learn about a skill set that you will not have as a young parent.

Critical, critical! Keep up your training, keep up your study! This is absolutely essential in the Kingdom, because the Kingdom is not only spiritual; it's also what? It's also physical; that's the big difference, isn't it? The big difference between an Old and New Testament church culture and a Completed Testament church culture. The Kingdom is not only spiritual; it's physical too. God requires us to have dominion physically too, and He calls us to be what? What did he say?
⁴ And when the chief Shepherd shall appear, ye shall receive a crown of glory.

He calls us to be what? Shepherds, kings, priests, queens, evangelists. What an honor! What an honor! What a tremendous honor! WHAT a tremendous blessing! WHAT a tremendous joy! We say, "Thank You, Father! Thank You, True Parents! Thank you, Jesus!" all the time for that. What a

tremendous honor! But also, it comes with TRAINING that we improve and we better ourselves with every day. Amen! All you got to do is do a little bit at a time slowly but surely, and after ten years you are black belt. Isn't that incredible? That's incredible! All you have to do is to not quit and keep praying. Isn't that incredible? That's how it happens. Right? It's incredible! God is good!

That's why 1 Peter 5 is so important, especially for such a beautiful growing community around. But remember these little kids, they listen to you now, but ten years down the road? Then in their twenties their life will be set in the right way to give God glory, bring Him joy, bring the community joy, learn how to serve others, and have a tremendous marriage themselves and wonderful children that they will raise in the same seriousness, the same light and same FUN. And they will have fun all the while doing God's work. Amen! PRAISE GOD ALMIGHTY! God is good! (*Applause*)
